

FINE ARTS POLICY

Preamble

The young people have multitude of God-given and acquired talents. The College is called to and is committed to provide variety of opportunities and programmes where the students can be guided to express their creativity and abilities. The non-academic activities have to focus to keep the students focussed in the right pursuits in their life and by exhibiting their inner selves.

Objectives

- ✓ To create atmosphere and opportunities for free expression of creativity and talents.
- ✓ To identify early and guide in order to polish and fine tune the talents in the youth.
- ✓ To encourage them to explore their inner selves.
- ✓ To let the youth come out of their shells and spend their energy in the right activities.
- ✓ To provide platform for comparative expressions in fine arts and improve their thought process for better performance.
- ✓ To stretch the students to the maximum limit for expression of talents.

General Guidelines

- The College shall give much importance to Fine Arts and include them as regular non-academic activities in the College.
- A Fine Arts Committee with a Fine Arts Coordinator shall be set up and all activities planned and organised by this Committee.
- Students shall be provided opportunities for regular practice and achievements during the Student Enrichment Academy (SEA) activities during the additional hour of College hours during 3 – 4 PM on all weekdays.
- The committee shall interact, observe and identify the talents and aptitude of the students and guide them to excel in one or two activities that the students are good at.
- All the Fine Arts Programmes shall be planned and executed well for the benefit of the students and youth.

- The Fine Arts Committee shall take all responsibilities in the organisation of events to ensure that the students perform well and they do obtain a learning experience.
- It is to be ensured that many students receive the opportunity to participate and excel in their talents and not limited to some students participating every time.
- The Fine Arts Committee shall plan and organise various inter-departmental events in order to provide opportunities for regular expression of fine arts by the students.
- The College shall observe various national and international days of importance and provide chance for the students for cultural and co-curricular activities.
- It shall be ensured that restrictions in the number of events to be participated by one student or group of students in order to encourage all students to identify their inner talents and participate in at least one event during an academic year.
- Department-wise identification of students shall be made to participate within the College events
- The selection of participants for Inter-College Events shall be made judiciously by providing opportunities for many to experience the wider level(s) competitions in their respective events / areas of interest.
- The College shall also organise Inter-College Events to explore the organisational skills in the youth.
