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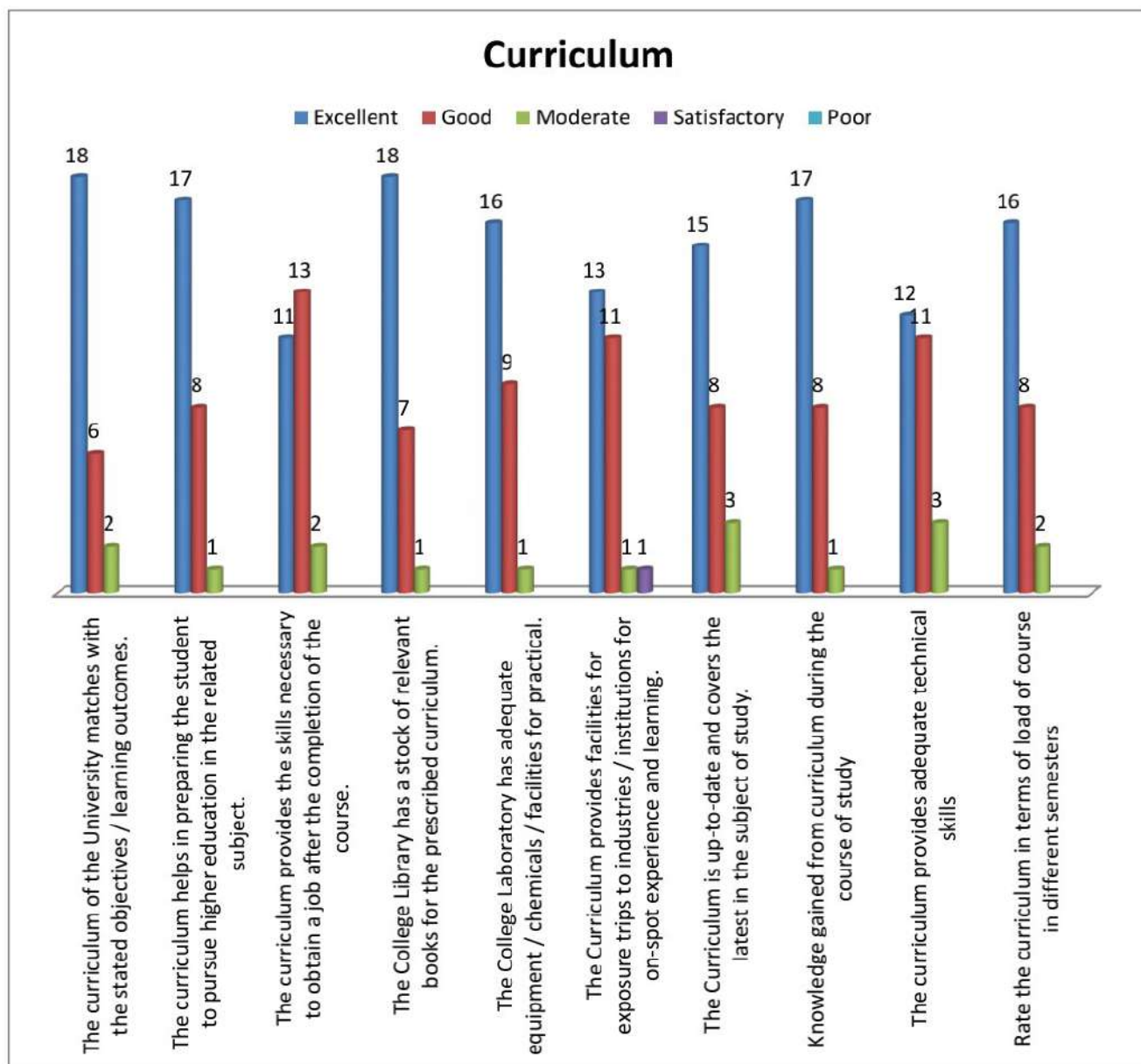

Analysis of Students feedback on Curriculum

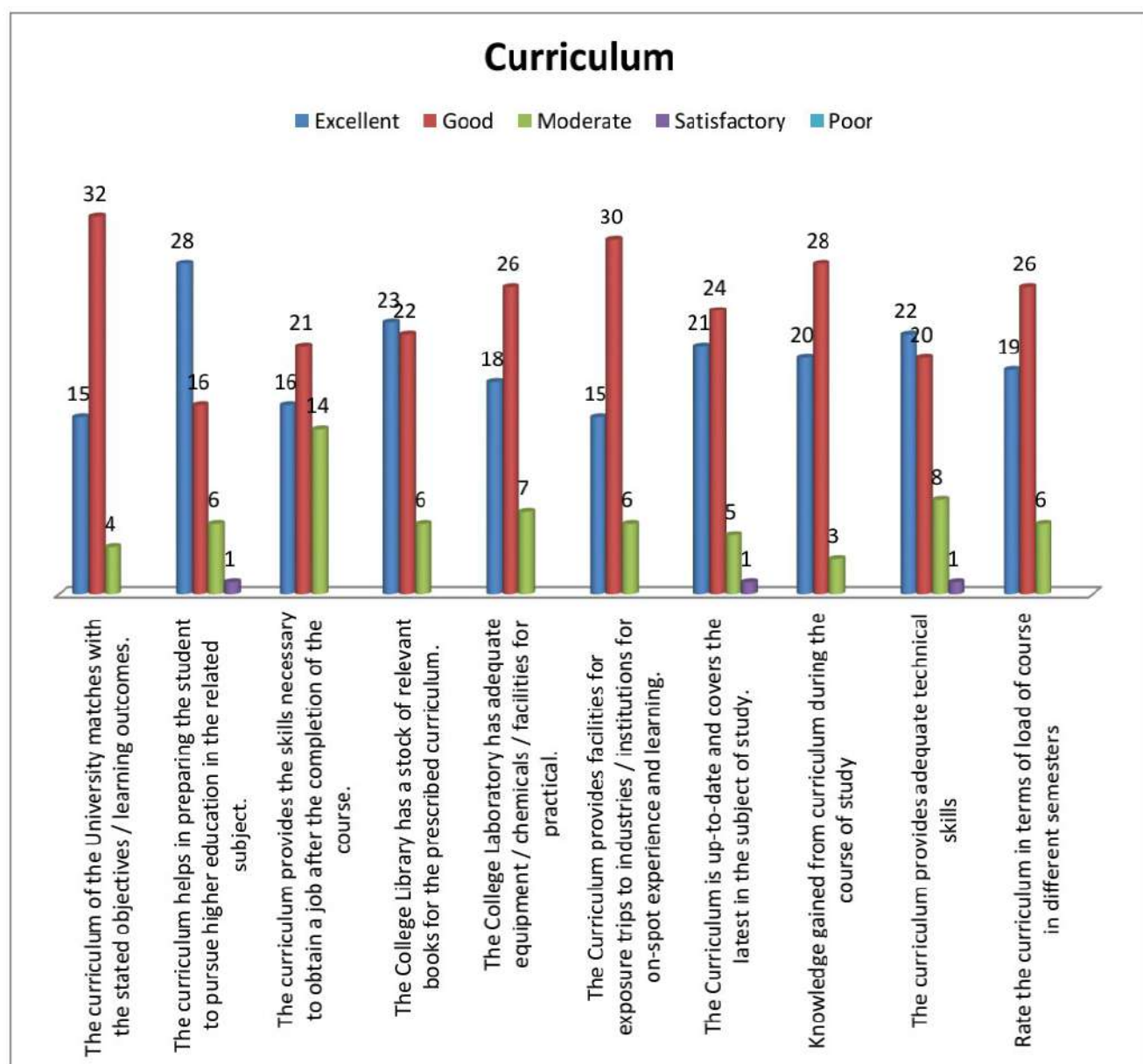

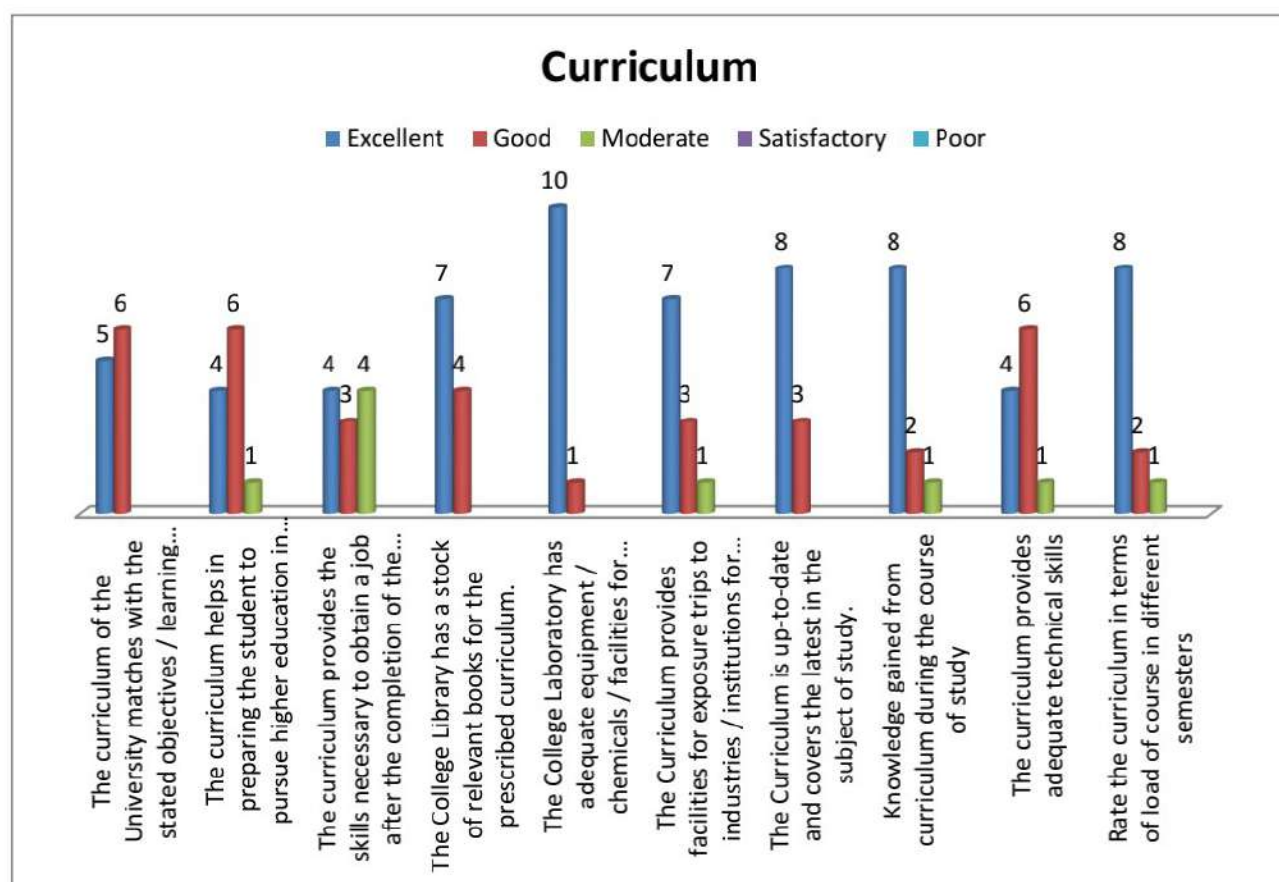

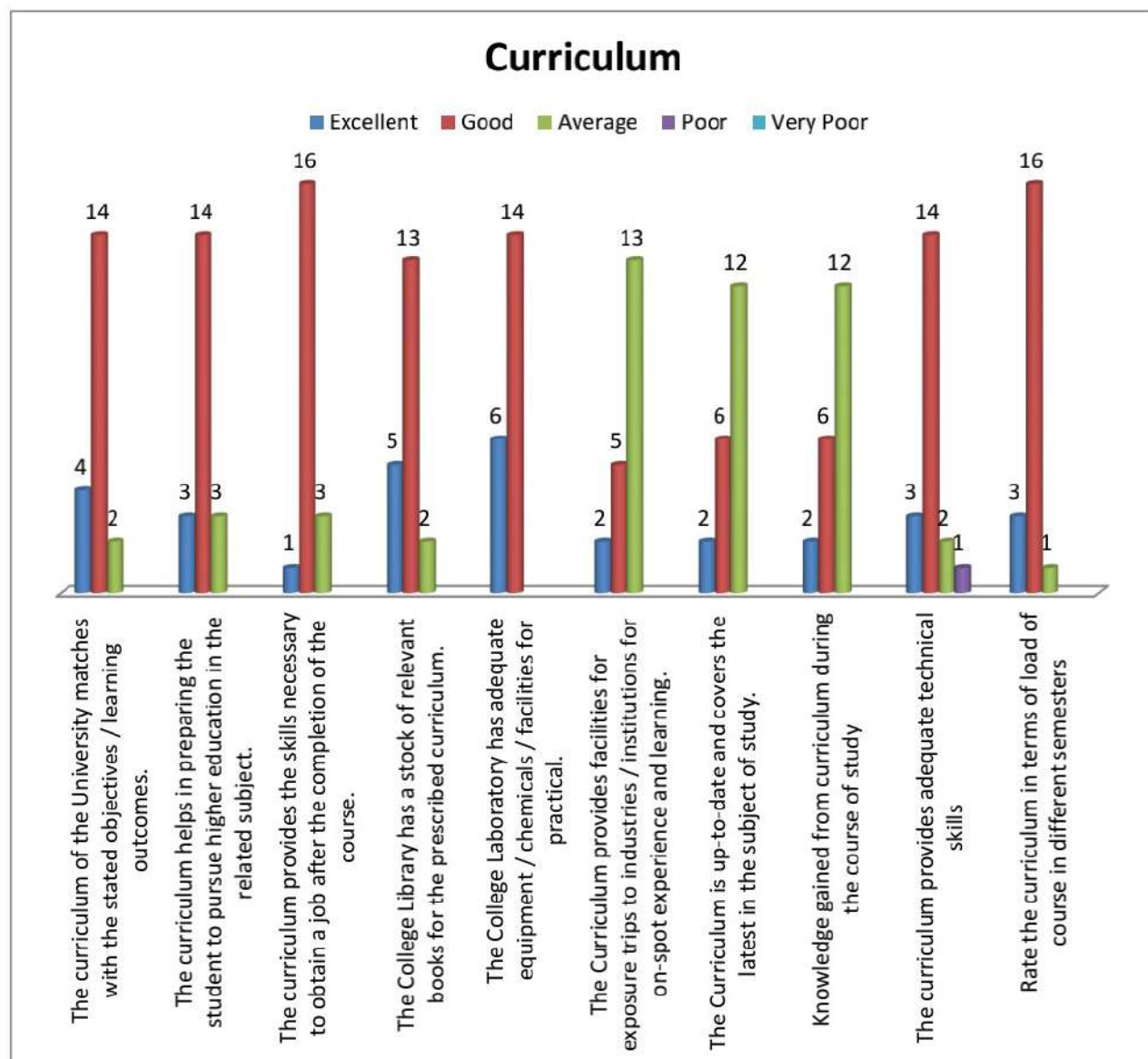

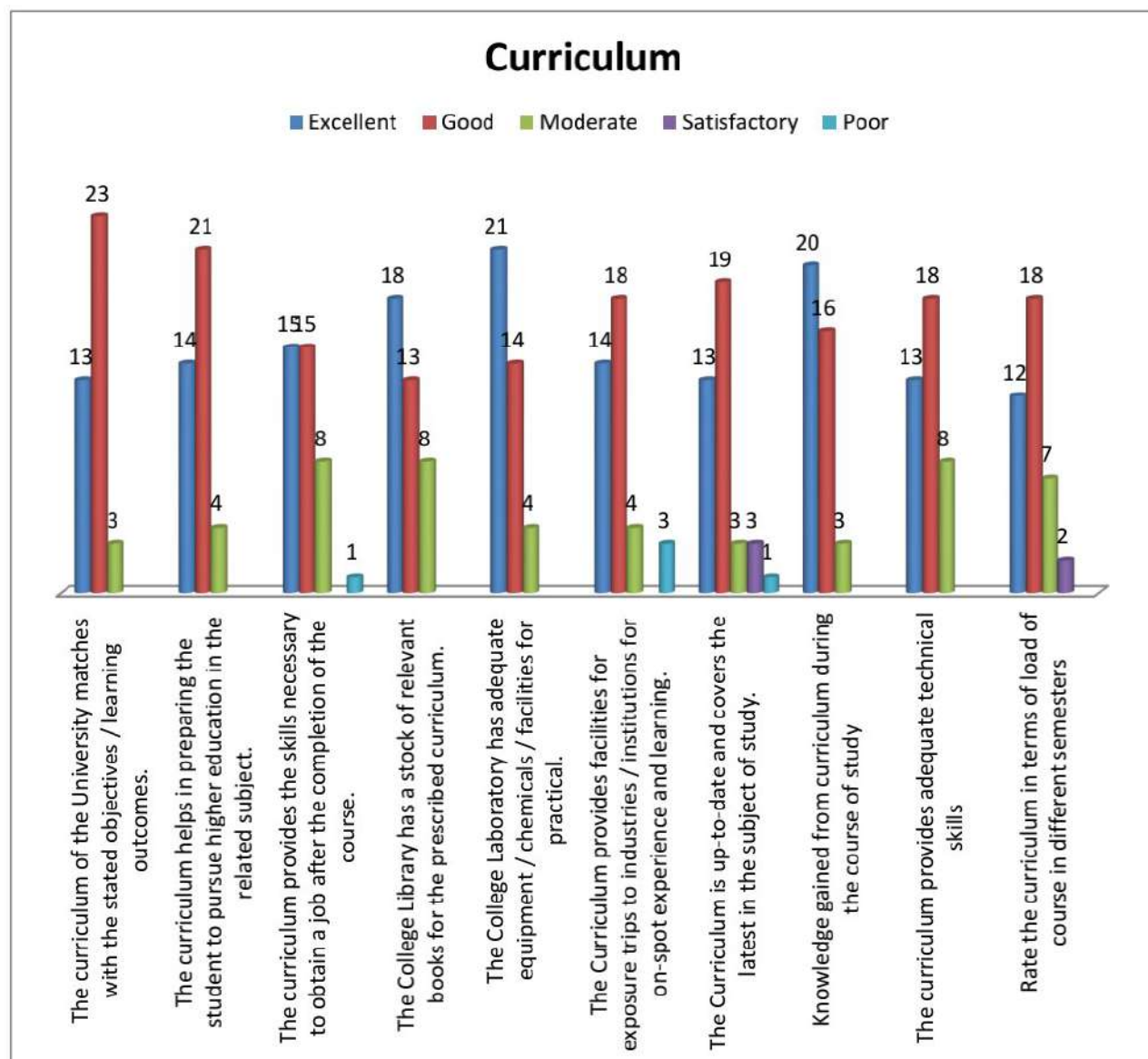

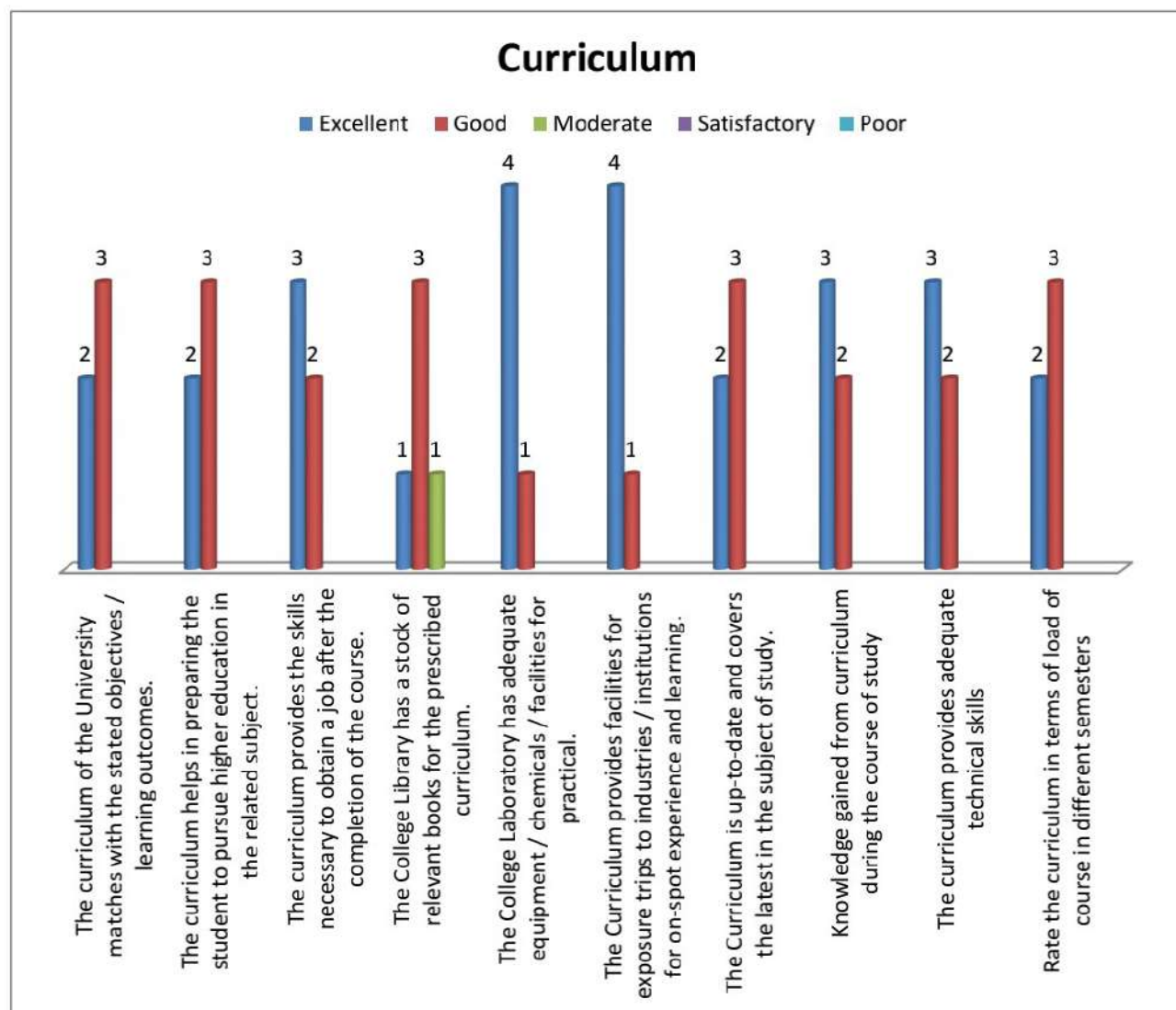

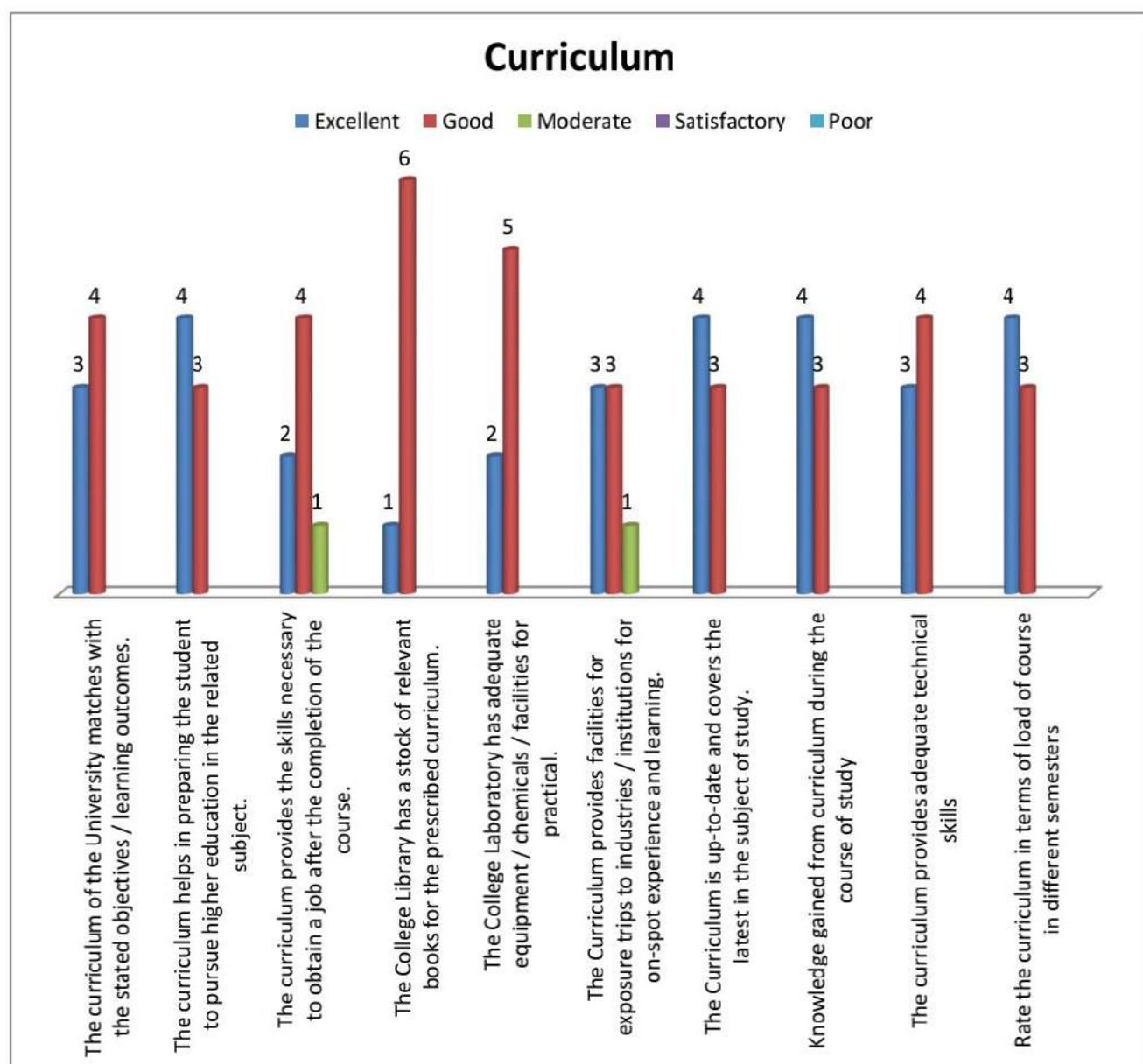

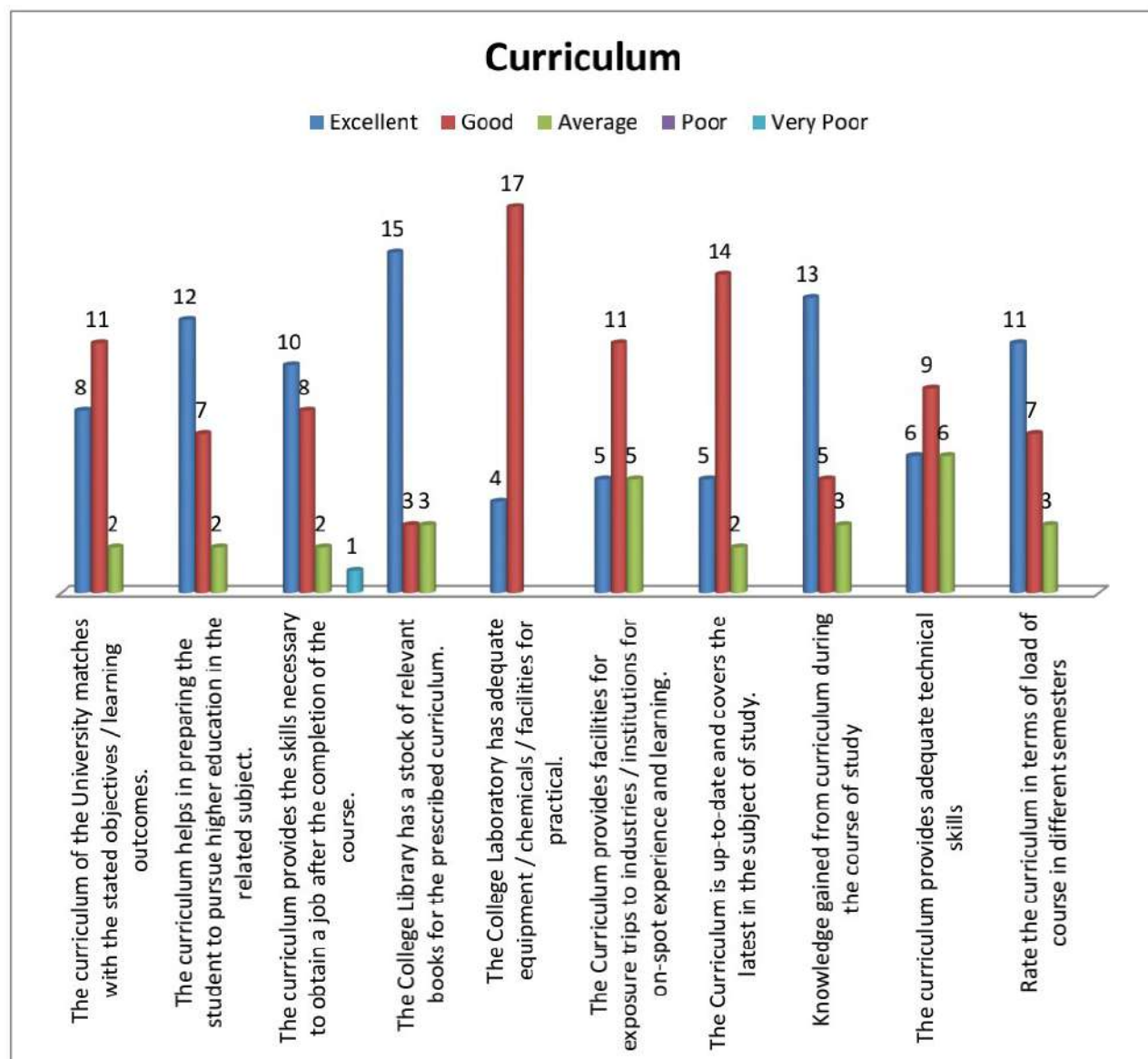

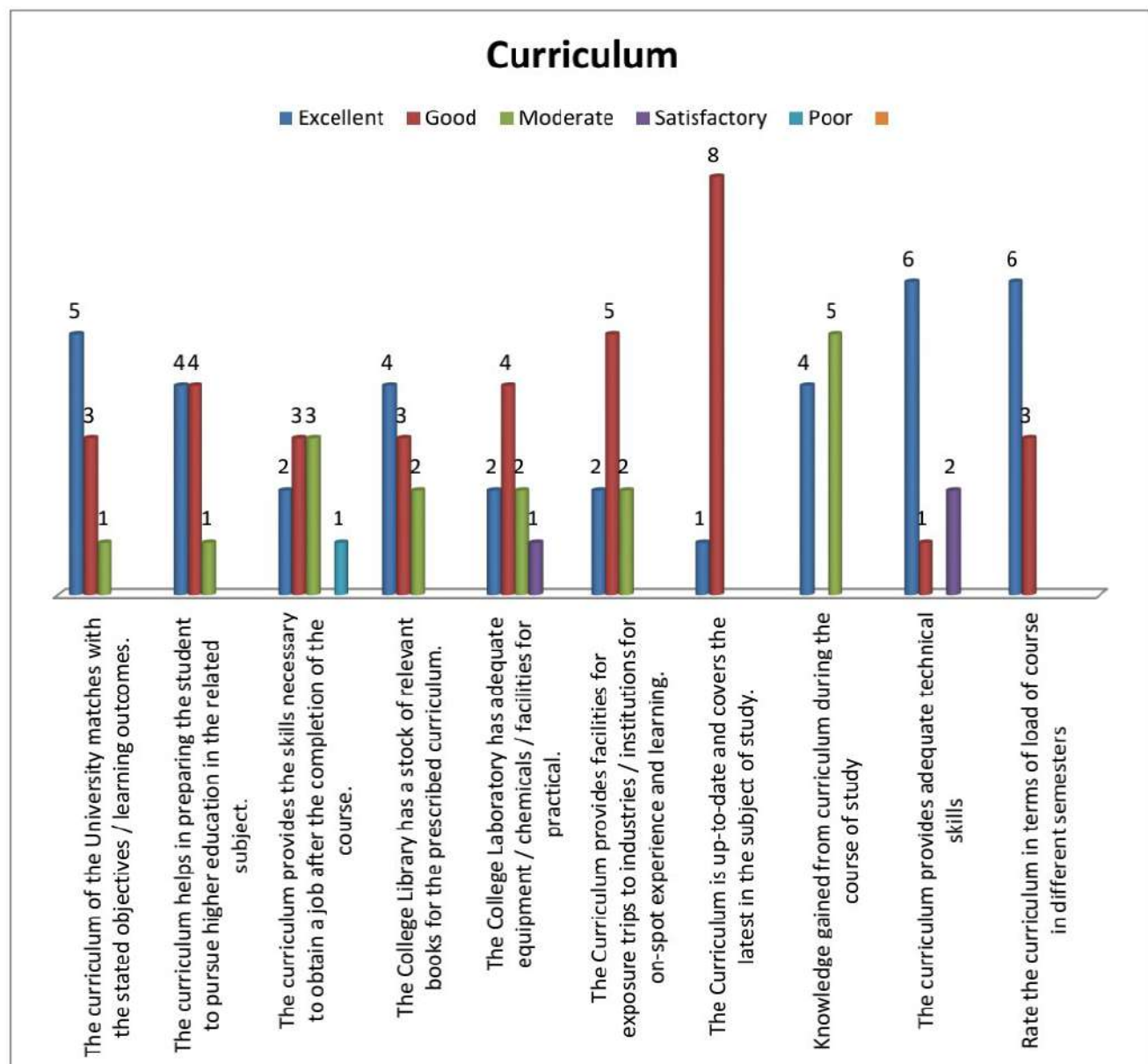

Feedback on the curriculum were collected from all the students of the institution for the academic batch 2018-2021.

- Out of 311 students, 189 recorded their opinion on the curriculum i.e., 61%
- From the graph, it is clear that 43% of the students rated the curriculum as excellent, 44% rated good, 11% rated average, 0.65% rated poor and 0.27% rated very poor.
- In general, the students are satisfied with the curriculum however, they urge to look into a few aspects of it.
